## Founder's Message

Dear Friends, organisers and well wishers,

I am truly amazed at this outpouring of support for Rumah Jaireh in Batu Arang. I can truly feel the love and support and encouragement. Special mention must be made with regards to Ms. Samantha Hooi and the staff of iKonxept, Ms. Michelle Ong and the staff of Megamix and Edwin Teow of Integrated Magazines Solutions and of course all the participants and their parents without whom this concert would not have become a reality.

Rumah Jaireh was set up in June 2005 after some soul searching and a stint at the men's home as a volunteer doctor. This home was set up for HIV positive women and children and those with special needs. The latter included those that did not fall into the eligibility criteria of those particular homes. This included those women recently discharged from prison and who have no place to go or their families do not accept them back, female drug addicts, abused and runaway women and maids. We are registered with the Selangor Registrar of Societies. However we receive no financial aid from any source, be it the welfare department or any NGO. We are operating right now in a rented bungalow, but we hope to get our own premises. Batu Arang was chosen as PJ and the Klang Valley are simply too expensive to rent. I would rather use any donations we receive for the residents' health and medical care. This includes transport to the 2 hospitals they are referred to - HKL for the kids and Sg. Buloh hospital for the adults and the needs of the 5 school going children also have to be met. To date we have admitted 100 cases of whom 7 succumbed to AIDS.

Whatever help we can receive especially from this concert will certainly go a long way in alleviating our expenses.
